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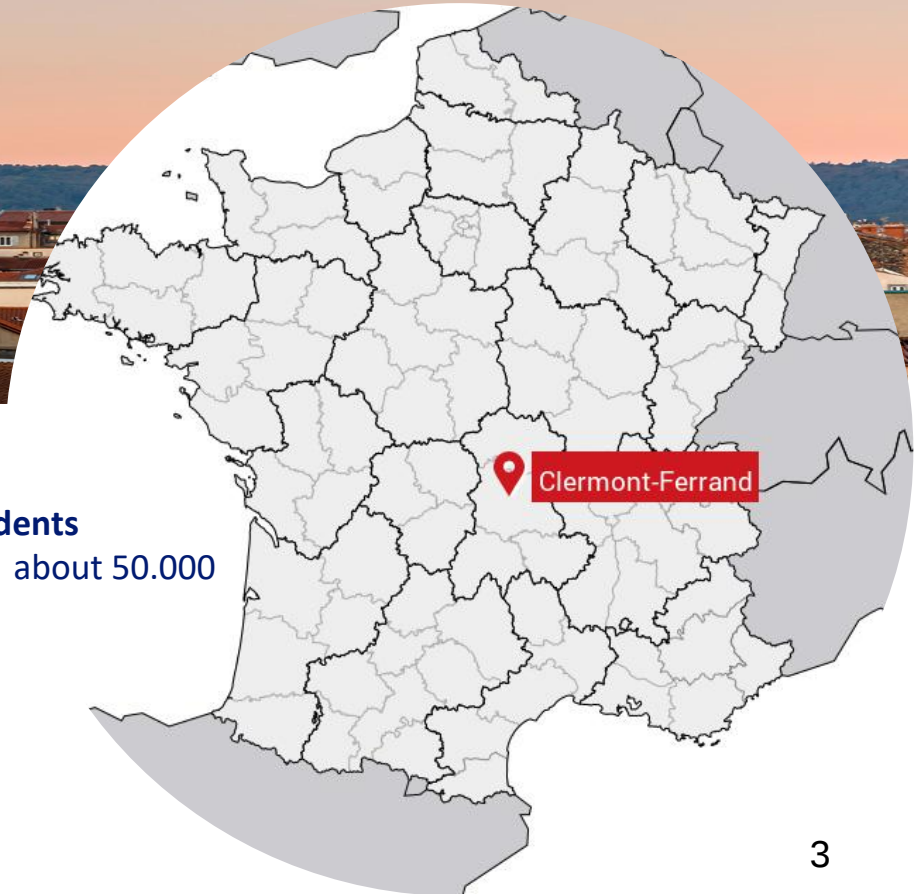

History of the Partnership since 1978/1979

- STWNO and Crous Clermont Auvergne have been partners since **1978**
- Inspiration: The city partnership between Regensburg and Clermont-Ferrand, established in **1969**
- First student exchange in 1979 in Clermont-Ferrand
- First staff exchange in 1981 in Regensburg
- Since then, a student exchange has generally taken place in one country and a staff exchange in the other country each year
- The objectives, organization, and funding of the exchange programs are set forth in a partnership agreement (current version from 2010)

Objectives of the Exchange Programs

Get to know your sister city, region, partner country, and its people.

To provide students and staff with an opportunity for exchange.

Focus on cultural activities, such as video, film, photography, or theater.

Promoting intercultural competence, teaching soft skills.

Motivate employees, foster intercultural competence, and provide inspiration.

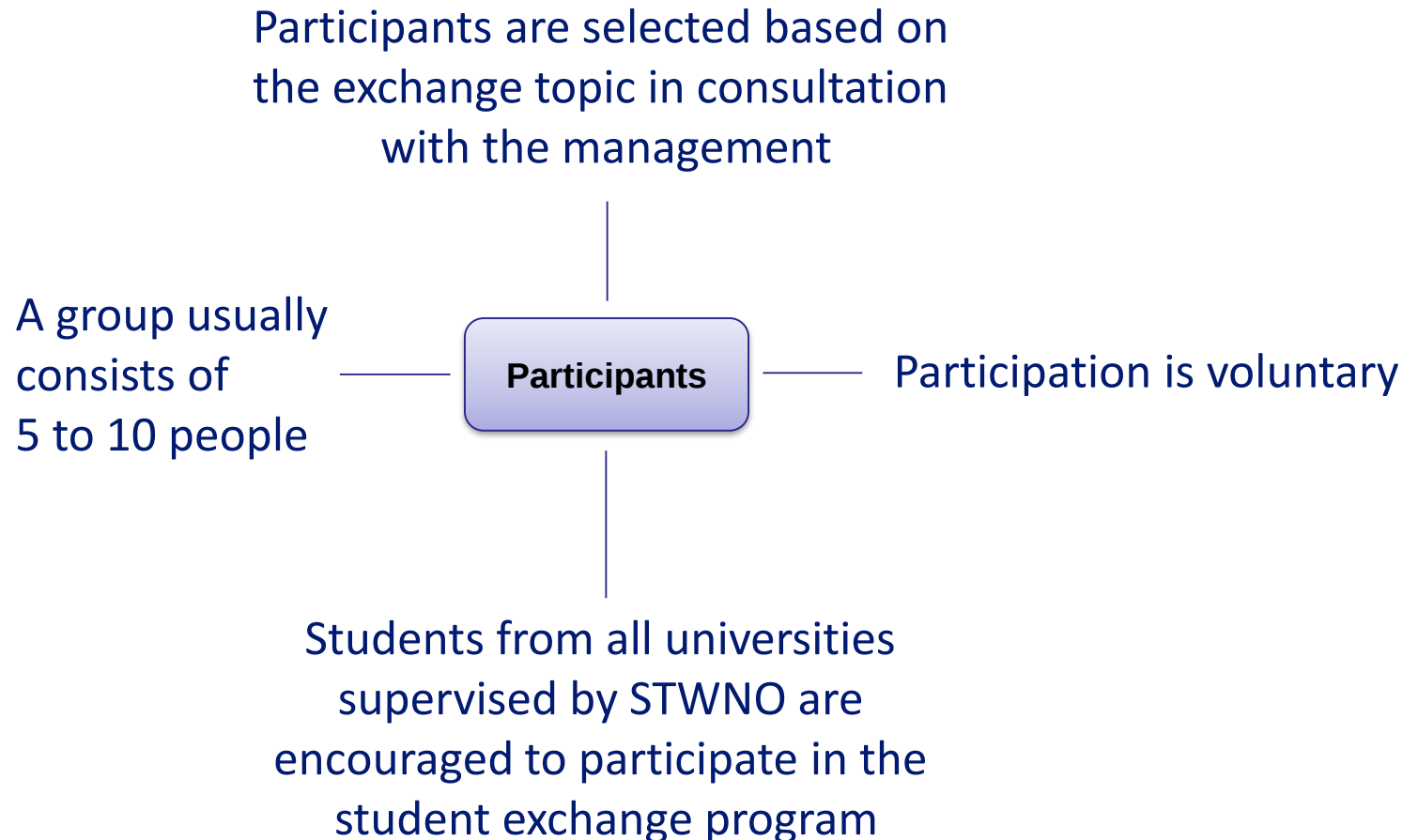

Partnership Agreement Between Germany and France

Financing

- STWNO and Crous agree to set aside a budget for partnership programs (business plan)
- STWNO and Crous are submitting a grant application to the German-French Youth Office (DFJW/OFAJ)
- The budget for student exchanges should not be less than the budget for staff exchanges
- The host partner covers the costs of lodging, meals, and project activities
- The traveling partner pays the transportation costs



Benefits of the Exchange for STWNO Employees

- Employees are given the opportunity to travel abroad
=> Thinking outside the box and changing perspectives
- By spending time together, employees from different departments and locations get to know each other better
=> Team cohesion is strengthened
- Thanks to similar tasks and challenges, different approaches and solutions are presented
=> Sharing new ideas and inspiration for one's own work
- Positive memories of STWNO as an employer
=> Strengthens employee retention

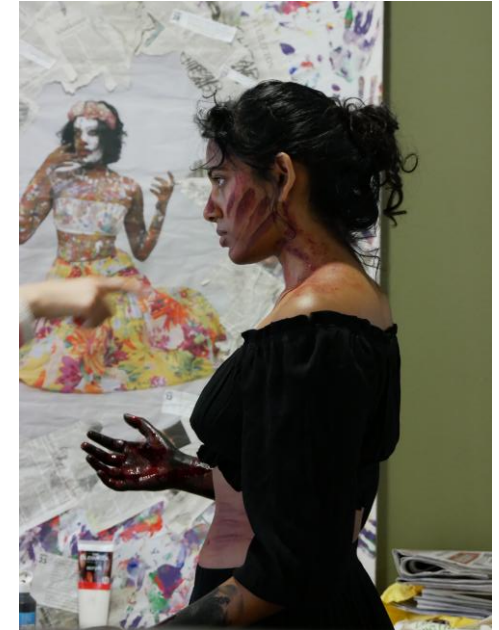
