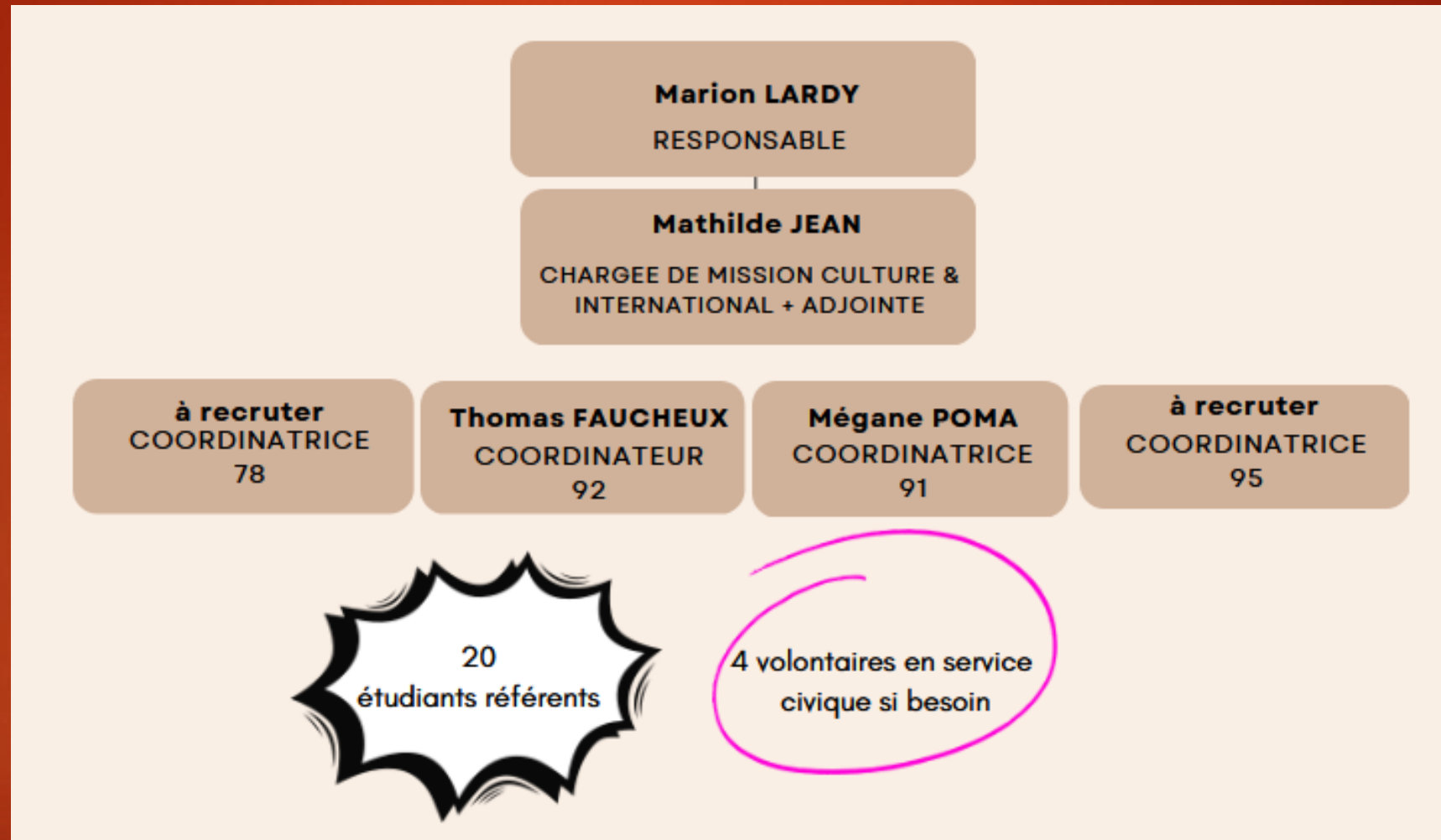

History :

Created during the COVID pandemic

Specific fund

Goal : check that everyone is okay and fight against loneliness

After the pandemic :

- main idea : use this mechanism to foster connections within the residence

Being a student representative today :

20 positions divided into 42 residences

Working time : 10h/week

Mental health awareness – creating a social life in the residence

Different activities :

Link with our coordinator to facilitate workshops and activities organized by our department

Organization of their own activities (games night, movies, sports ...)

Organization of activities out of the residence (more explanation with the Pass CVEC)



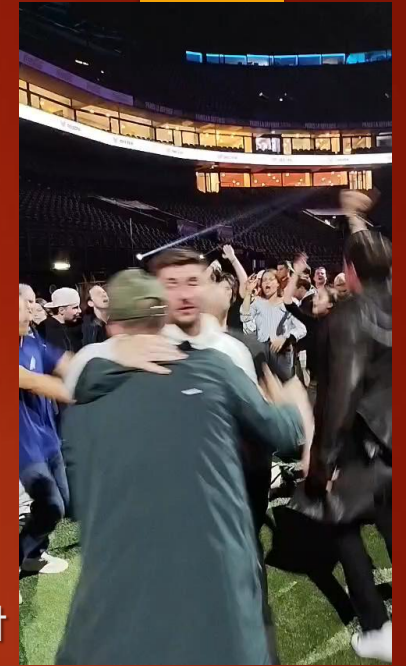

Events during the FULL year :

COP1 Festival 1st of November 2025 – free tickets and team present during the event
Christmas Bus Tour (29 & 30 of December) – manage by representatives students
Rugby Game – Racing 92 – 10 of May for 100 students
FFSU – during the summer 1 or 2 weeks of sports organized by the department
and manage with the representatives students
Guiguettes de fin d'année – June 2026 – end of the year event – participative budget

WHY THIS EXPERIMENTAL SETUP ?

4 REASONS :

- Communication tool to talk about the CVEC
- Provide a tool for cultural discovery and sports participation
- Compensate for the lack of dedicated sports and cultural facilities
- Promote a free service for all the students regardless of where they study

CVEC – Contribution vie étudiante et de campus

Earmarked tax – Every student enrolled in an initial higher education program must, prior to enrollment, obtain a certificate confirming payment of the Student and Campus Life Contribution (CVEC)—whether through actual payment or an exemption.

105 euros a year per student, collected by the Crous but redistributed to the establishments, and the Crous keeps around 10% of it.

Crous de Versailles budget : 2,2M a year

Advantages :

- Possibility to easily multiply partners
- Possibility of offering a scheme to ALL students in the academy—funded by their membership fee even those located furthest from the main campuses.
- Enable cultural and sporting discovery
- Health: Combating a sedentary lifestyle
- No in-house management of show scheduling

Levers for supporting students in precarious situations – resources and action plans

1. Creating link between student
2. Offering free activities
3. Building tools with the students and for the students (participative budget & activities in residences)
4. Present activities that students enjoy, but also opportunities to discover new things
5. Being able to have a team
6. Build teams attuned to student schedules (involving non-standard working hours and schedule management balancing fieldwork with administrative tasks).
